### Call for nominations in the 2021 Health category.

**Eligibility:** Al-Sumait Prize, Health category, is open to individuals who are nominated by universities (etc), and open to institutions and organizations delivering pioneering and high-impact contributions to solving health challenges in Africa, with a special focus in the 2021 cycle on the utilization of effective frameworks and programs to resolve and manage health crises such as SARS, COVID-19 and infectious zoonotic diseases, as well as provision of medical staff for health care systems, capacity building in medical research and national medical education and upgrading and maintenance of national medical facilities.



**Nominations must be received by Al-Sumait's Prize Office no later than June 30, 2021.**
